

**FREE TRADE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CANADA AND THE REPUBLIC OF
PERU**

**DECISION No. 1 OF THE JOINT COMMISSION CONCERNING UNIFORM
REGULATIONS REGARDING ARTICLE 402(4)**

THE JOINT COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Free Trade Agreement between Canada and the Republic of Peru (“Agreement”), signed in Lima on 29 May 2008, and in particular Articles 402(4), 407 and 2001 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Article 407 (Uniform Regulations) of the Agreement provides that the Parties may establish and implement, through their respective laws, regulations or administrative policies, Uniform Regulations regarding the interpretation, application and administration of the Chapter concerning Origin Procedures and Trade Facilitation; and
- (2) Article 2001 (The Joint Commission) provides that the Joint Commission may further the implementation of the objectives of the Agreement by approving any revisions of the Uniform Regulations on Origin Procedures that the Parties may develop,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

To establish Uniform Regulations regarding the administration and interpretation of Article 402(4) (Obligations Regarding Importations) as set out in the Annex to this Decision.
